

Task 2 Find a real world object in your house that are shaped like a circle, square, and triangle. Draw a picture of each shape and then draw the object next to the shape.	Task 2 Look around your home and find things that use your five senses. (see, hear, taste, touch, smell). Draw a detailed picture of the things that you find.
